



TORN IN BETWEEN FOREIGN POLICY OF KOREA DURING MOON JAE-IN ERA

This monograph focuses on the bilateral relations between ROK – U.S. and ROK – PRC on key areas of Moon Jae-in's foreign policy throughout 2017 – 2021. There is a lack of research on the influence of engagements between each country towards the foreign policy of ROK and the lean of the policies throughout Moon Jae-in's presidency. This monograph gathers engagement data between ROK – U.S. and ROK – PRC from 2017 – 2021 to highlight the main foreign policies and/or adjustments made by ROK and its influence towards the lean in ROK's foreign policy – towards the U.S. or PRC. The methodology used in this monograph is qualitative method, mainly on analyzing the foreign policy of ROK from 2017 – 2021 through its bilateral engagements with the U.S. and PRC. From the data gathered and analyzed, it is seen that each year from 2017 – 2021, there are different leans of the ROK foreign policy choices and approaches. This is derived from data of the engagements of ROK – U.S. and ROK – PRC which differed in both frequency and substance throughout Moon Jae-in's presidency. Despite the similarities, there are still differences in the engagements, approaches, and accommodations of ROK towards both the U.S. and PRC – concerning different issues. This shows the willingness of Moon Jae-in to appease both the U.S. and PRC through different ways and in different key areas – though there are certain aspects which caused ROK to clearly show a certain lean towards one country through the analysis of the data of ROK – U.S. and ROK – PRC engagements.
