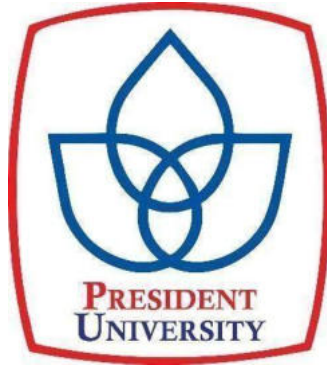

The urgency of this research is motivated by the phenomenon of disparity between normative regulations and factual implementation in the performance of Bekasi City DPRD members, which is reflected in the low level of attendance at sessions, minimal legislative initiatives, and weak oversight functions of the executive. The Bekasi City DPRD has issued Regulation Number 01 of 2024 concerning Rules of Procedure as an effort to improve the discipline and accountability of its members performance. However, the effectiveness of the implementation of this regulation is still questionable due to challenges in enforcing discipline and transparency. The formulation of the problem in this study is an analysis of the provisions in DPRD Regulation Number 01 of 2024 and its implementation in improving the discipline and accountability of DPRD members performance. This study uses a normative legal methodology with a statute approach and a conceptual approach, as well as data collection techniques based on literature studies of primary and secondary sources. The conclusion of the study shows that although DPRD Regulation Number 01 of 2024 contains comprehensive provisions regarding performance standards and sanctions for violations, its implementation still faces obstacles such as low member awareness, weak internal supervision, and lack of transparency.

ABSTRAK

Urgensi penelitian ini dilatarbelakangi oleh fenomena disparitas antara regulasi normatif dan implementasi faktual dalam kinerja anggota DPRD Kota Bekasi, yang tercermin dari rendahnya tingkat kehadiran dalam sidang, minimnya inisiatif legislasi, serta lemahnya fungsi pengawasan terhadap eksekutif. DPRD Kota Bekasi telah menerbitkan Peraturan Nomor 01 Tahun 2024 tentang Tata Tertib sebagai upaya untuk meningkatkan disiplin dan akuntabilitas kinerja anggotanya. Namun, efektivitas implementasi peraturan ini masih dipertanyakan karena adanya tantangan dalam penegakan disiplin dan transparansi. Rumusan masalah dalam penelitian ini adalah analisis terhadap ketentuan dalam Peraturan DPRD Nomor 01 Tahun 2024 serta implementasinya dalam meningkatkan disiplin dan akuntabilitas kinerja anggota DPRD. Penelitian ini menggunakan metodologi yuridis normatif dengan pendekatan perundang-undangan (statute approach) dan pendekatan konseptual (conceptual approach), serta teknik pengumpulan data berbasis studi kepustakaan terhadap sumber primer dan sekunder. Kesimpulan penelitian menunjukkan bahwa meskipun Peraturan DPRD Nomor 01 Tahun 2024 telah memuat ketentuan komprehensif mengenai standar kinerja dan sanksi pelanggaran, implementasinya masih menghadapi kendala seperti rendahnya kesadaran anggota, lemahnya pengawasan internal, dan kurangnya transparansi.
