



**“POVERTY IN KAMPUNG NELAYAN MUSTIKA KALI
ADEM BASED ON THE PERSPECTIVE OF FISHERMEN
COMMUNITY IN THE CONTEXT OF SDG”**

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ABSTRACT

Poverty is a difficult problem for the Indonesian government to tackle, especially in coastal communities, which has an impact on the welfare of fishermen. The aim of our research is to develop targeted and sustainable solutions to reduce poverty in Kali Adem, which aligns with one of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), namely "No Poverty." The method we used to write this research is a qualitative method aimed at obtaining a comprehensive understanding of individuals' life experiences in the community and answering research questions related to poverty, access to resources, and livelihood sustainability. We collected our data by conducting direct surveys with 70 fishermen in Kampung Nelayan Kali Adem. The results of our research found that the average income of fishermen in Kali Adem is less than 1 million per month, forcing them to seek income from other livelihoods. Our research concluded that structural challenges such as limited access to education, economic dependence on fisheries, and environmental degradation significantly affect the livelihoods of the residents.

ABSTRAK

Kemiskinan merupakan masalah yang sulit untuk dihadapi oleh pemerintahan Indonesia, terutama yang terjadi di masyarakat pesisir, yang mana memiliki dampak terhadap kesejahteraan nelayan. Tujuan dari penelitian kami adalah mengembangkan solusi yang terarah dan berkelanjutan untuk mengurangi kemiskinan di Kali Adem, yang mana hal tersebut sejalan dengan salah satu Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) yaitu “No Poverty”. Metode yang kami gunakan untuk menulis penelitian ini adalah metode kualitatif bertujuan untuk mendapatkan pemahaman yang komprehensif tentang pengalaman hidup individu dalam komunitas dan menjawab pertanyaan penelitian terkait kemiskinan, akses sumber daya, dan keberlanjutan mata pencaharian. Data kami kumpulkan dengan cara melakukan survey langsung terhadap nelayan sebanyak 70 orang di Kampung Nelayan Kali Adem. Hasil dari penelitian kami menemukan bahwa pendapatan rata-rata nelayan di Kali Adem adalah kurang dari 1 juta perbulan, sehingga memaksa mereka untuk mencari penghasilan dari mata pencaharian lain. Penelitian kami menyimpulkan bahwa tantangan struktural seperti akses terbatas ke pendidikan, ketergantungan ekonomi pada perikanan, dan degradasi lingkungan secara signifikan mempengaruhi mata pencaharian penduduk.
