

ABSTRACT

Title: Contribution and Challenge of RSPO Policy towards Strengthening Indonesia's

palm oil sustainability

This study on Indonesia's growing palm oil industry has led to various issues of

unsustainability such as environmental damage and biodiversity loss to various

violations of social norms. The Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) is an

improvement in the global palm oil industry formed by various stakeholders and

sectors of the palm oil industry that aims to create and encourage sustainable palm oil

production based on credible global standards through voluntary certification. The

purpose of this study is to analyze the implementation of RSPO policies related to the

sustainability of Indonesian palm oil with descriptive analysis methods. For this

reason, this research uses the green theory approach as the main theoretical concept

which is then followed by a supporting theory, namely the theory of self-regulation.

As a result, the study concludes that the RSPO's role in the implementation of its

policies poses challenges to the strength of its legitimacy as a non-state actor. However,

RSPO is able to contribute to the improvement of the sustainability of the Indonesian

palm oil industry. In addition, RSPO certification also makes it easier for producers to

export to the global market. Therefore, these challenges are less than the contribution

or benefits of implementing RSPO certification.

ABSTRAK

Judul : Kontribusi dan Tantangan kebijakan RSPO Terhadap Penguatan Minyak Sawit Berkelanjutan di Indonesia

Studi ini mengenai industri kelapa sawit Indonesia yang semakin berkembang telah menyebabkan timbulnya berbagai isu-isu ketidakberlanjutan seperti rusaknya lingkungan dan hilangnya keanekaragaman hayati hingga berbagai pelanggaran norma-norma sosial. Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil (RSPO) merupakan suatu langkah perbaikan pada industri minyak kelapa sawit dunia yang dibentuk oleh berbagai pemangku kepentingan dan sektor industri minyak kelapa sawit yang bertujuan untuk menciptakan serta mendorong produksi minyak kelapa sawit yang berkelanjutan berdasarkan standar global yang kredibel melalui sertifikasi sukarela. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menganalisis terkait implementasi kebijakan RSPO terdap keberlanjutan minyak kelapa sawit indonesia dengan metode analisis deskriptif. Untuk itu pada penelitiaan ini menggunakan pendekatan teori politik hijau sebagai konsep teori utama yang kemudian diikuti dengan teori pendukung yakni teori regulasi diri. Sebagai hasilnya, penelitian ini menyimpulkan bahwa peran RSPO dalam implementasi kebijakannya meninmbulkan berbagai tantangan mengenai kekuatan legitimasinya sebagai aktor non-negara. Namun, RSPO mampu berkontribusi pada penigkatan keberlajutan industry minyak kelapa sawit Indonesia selain itu sertifikasi RSPO juga memudahkan produsen untuk melakukan ekpor pada pasar global. Oleh karena itu, tantangan tersebut lebih sedikit dibandingkan dengan kontribusi ataupun manfaat dari penerapan sertifikasi RSPO.
