This study aims to operate and apply the Hexagon Model by Simon Anholt's Nation branding in the case of G20 Tourism Track Meeting 2022 from Indonesia Presidency. Analysing how the agenda could present Indonesia as a brand in a prestigious international forum opportunity through one of the most-used concepts of nation branding in international relations is an interesting new approach.
