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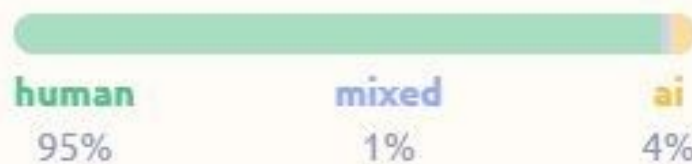


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ABSTRACT

On October 12, 2002, Indonesia suffered a major terrorist attack in what would be known as the First Bali Bombing. This thesis explores the critical role of organizational culture in facilitating effective cooperation between the Australian Federal Police and the Indonesian National Police during the first Bali bombing investigation in 2002. This research employs qualitative research methods specifically focusing on primary data in the form of corresponding journals, books, articles, and documents related to cooperation between the Australian Federal Police and the Indonesian National Police to gain valuable insights into organizational culture and cooperation dynamics. This approach allowed the author to examine and interpret the data comprehensively, thus providing a deeper understanding of the topic. By analyzing key case studies, this research aims to explain the importance of fostering a shared organizational culture and building strong relationships to enhance international law enforcement cooperation. The main finding is the impact of cultural differences, strategic cooperation, and collaborative practices on the success of joint operations between the two law enforcement agencies. The findings of this research provide valuable insights and recommendations for future collaboration in counterterrorism efforts between countries.

ABSTRAK

Pada tanggal 12 Oktober 2002, Indonesia mengalami serangan teroris besar yang kemudian dikenal sebagai Bom Bali I. Tesis ini mengeksplorasi peran penting budaya organisasi dalam memfasilitasi kerja sama yang efektif antara Kepolisian Federal Australia dan Kepolisian Republik Indonesia selama investigasi Bom Bali I pada tahun 2002. Tesis ini menyelidiki dampak dari perbedaan budaya, komunikasi strategis, dan praktik-praktik kolaboratif terhadap keberhasilan operasi gabungan antara kedua lembaga penegak hukum tersebut. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode penelitian kualitatif yang secara khusus berfokus pada data primer berupa jurnal, buku, artikel, dan dokumen yang terkait dengan kerja sama antara Kepolisian Federal Australia dan Kepolisian Republik Indonesia untuk mendapatkan wawasan yang berharga tentang budaya organisasi dan dinamika kerja sama. Pendekatan ini memungkinkan penulis untuk memeriksa dan menginterpretasikan data secara komprehensif, sehingga memberikan pemahaman yang lebih mendalam tentang topik tersebut. Dengan menganalisis studi kasus utama, penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menjelaskan pentingnya membina budaya organisasi bersama dan membangun hubungan yang kuat untuk meningkatkan kerja sama penegakan hukum internasional. Temuan utamanya adalah dampak perbedaan budaya, kerja sama strategis, dan praktik kolaboratif terhadap keberhasilan operasi gabungan kedua lembaga penegak hukum. Temuan penelitian ini memberikan wawasan dan rekomendasi yang berharga untuk kolaborasi di masa depan dalam upaya kontraterorisme antar negara.
