A CRITICAL SOCIAL SEMIOTIC APPROACH ON TEXT-IMAGE RELATIONSHIP

Revisiting Bali Nine Ringleaders

The interplay between photographs and texts mostly has been studied in analysing advertisement discourse through the application of both Fairclough's three dimensional discursive framework of Critical Discourse Analysis (CDA) in combination with Kress and Leeuwen's ground-breaking social semiotic framework of Visual Grammar Analysis (VG). However, despite the apparent existing connection of visual and verba texts in both printed and online news stories, the intersemiotic meaning analysis of a news photograph combined with its accompanying texts such as headlines and captions remains under-researched Therefore, this book aims to address this gap and add to the growing body of knowledge through analysing the discourse of news photographs and their accompanying texts, since it is paramount to analyse news discourse as it has considerable power to shape and influence our values and beliefs as we live as members of our social groups through watching, reading, and sharing the news. Taking the context of 'Bali Nine Ringleaders' that was causing tensions between Indonesia and Australia, this book examines the competing discourse related to the capital punishment of the Bali Nine in the news stories of Indonesian and Australian news outlets, Jakarta Globe and The Australian respectively. Employing the combined theoretical frameworks of CDA and VG, the analysis of text-image relationship (multimodality) between the news photographs and their headings and captions reveals that each of the two news outlets made active choices to position the two Bali Nine Ringleaders and the two governments in relation to the audience.
